<u>Minutes</u>- Gene Posivio moved to accept March minutes with corrections for the Mission District, Tim Orr  $2^{nd}$  that motion. The motion was carried out unanimously.

Tracy Gardner moved to accept corrected March minutes for the Jocko District, Patty Hahn 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. The motion was carried out unanimously.

<u>Warrants</u>- Ray Swenson moved to accept the Warrants for this month for the Mission District, Gene Posivio 2<sup>nd</sup> that motion. The motion was carried out unanimously.

Tim Orr contacted the county about a protest payment, but discovered that it is not applicable in our situation because we are paying the B.I.A. directly.

We discovered that the BIA will accept payments from the districts only, and not individual irrigators.

April 16, 2019 at 3pm the three chairmen will meet with the BIA at Project headquarters. The spring presentation will be held for the public at Ninepipes at 5 P.M.

Our election has been postponed 60 days; therefore, we can expect to vote in mid-July.

All three districts have agreed to put a half page ad in the Valley Journal to run for a couple of weeks come May, to explain to the irrigators exactly how this election is going to run, to minimize on anymore confusion on the matter.

It was mentioned that our printer/copier in the Mission/Jocko office will eventually need a new touch pad, which has been estimated at \$250, not including labor.
